Considerando o disposto no parágrafo único do artigo 2.º e no parágrafo 2.º do artigo 7.º, ambos da citada resolução n.º 42,


**R E S O L V E:**


Art. 2.º - Este ato entra em vigor na data de sua publicação, revogadas as disposições em contrário.
